Remembrance Assembly

Poppy Appeal

Unfortunately, we have not received our usual supply of poppies and other merchandise from the Poppy Appeal this year. Poppies are usually on sale in supermarkets and other public areas – please do support this very worthwhile cause if you can.

<u>Attendance</u>

Monitoring of children's attendance at school has always been important and is also a legal requirement. When reporting an absence for your child, please give the specific reason — the reason "unwell" is not sufficient. We have also noticed an increase in the number of children who have sustained an injury whilst playing football (for example). An injury, unless serious, is not a reason for a child to be absent from school. We can ensure that your child remains inside at break/lunch times, is able to elevate their leg whilst in class and even administer pain relief (with your permission). It is really important for your child to attend school, if they are well enough to do so.

If your child's attendance falls below 95% (even if the absences are authorised), you may receive a letter from me outlining the importance of regular school attendance.

I would like to remind parents that it is your responsibility to notify the school if your child is absent. Absences can be reported via ParentMail, StudyBugs or a message left on the school absence line. Please be aware that if you do not report your child's absence by 9.20am (unless in an emergency), the absence, for whatever reason, will be recorded as unauthorised.

Doggy Centre

I was disappointed to hear from the Doggy Centre on Elizabeth Road that some of our children have been involved in unsociable behaviour at the Doggy Centre on their way to or from school. This has included banging on doors, hitting doors and fences with sticks. The staff feel intimidated by this behaviour and it can be very distressing for the dogs in their care. The centre has been advised to contact the police if this type of behaviour happens again as it has resulted in criminal damage to their property.

I will be speaking to the children about this behaviour during assembly and I would be grateful if you could reinforce the message at home too. Thank you
