Headteacher's message

Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back everyone and a very Happy New Year to you all.



Our Year 5 children have kicked off 2025 with their residential visit to Calshot Activities Centre. This is a first for Purbrook Junior School – usually the visit happens during December. I have kept in regular contact with the staff at Calshot, and also seen the wonderful photos of the children posted to social media. It looks as though they have had an amazing time, and I look forward to hearing about their adventures when they return.

Only 4 children in Year 5 have remained in school and what a week they have had! Mrs Piller and Mrs Ravenscroft have kept them busy making:

- jewellery and charms using polymer clay

On Thursday afternoon they built an indoor tent and had a pyjama party. It is amazing how quiet the school has seemed, with almost a whole year group missing!

Year 4 kicked off 2025 with a robot workshop on Thursday this week. Using Lego Spike, the children designed, engineered and built their own robots, in both simple and complex forms. The children incorporated a range of motors, ultrasonic sensors and more into their designs to build robots that were capable of taking on a range of challenges. The workshop was designed around their new Iron Man topic and combined the elements of science, DT and computing. The children were fully engaged throughout the workshop and had a really great time.
